Ron M. Jordan, age 66, of Rensselaer, passed away Saturday, September 25, 2021 at Franciscan East in Lafayette.

He was born in Rensselaer on March 14, 1955, the son of Robert and Frances (Culp) Jordan. He married Suzanne Norris on July 14, 1979.

A 1973 graduate of Rensselaer Central High School, Ron was self-employed in his floral/gift shop. He was involved in various civic organizations, including Rensselaer Advanced Youth Soccer, which led to the development of RCHS Soccer. For 27 years, Ron served on the board of the Carnegie Players, an organization that was near and dear to his heart. He was also a member of the Jasper Newton Foundation, a St. Joseph's College Fellow, and a member of First Presbyterian Church of Rensselaer.

He is survived by his wife Suzanne, daughters Tiffany (Norm) Wika of Saginaw, MI and Lesley Jordan of Indianapolis, and granddaughter Hannah Wika, and one brother. He is preceded in death by his parents Robert and Frances Jordan of Rensselaer, and one brother.

No formal visitation is planned at this time, with a private burial at a later date.


