



Alice Van Kley

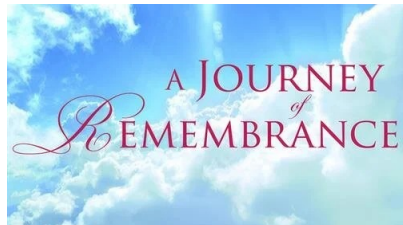
March 8, 1930 - May 3, 2011
