Alma Lesh, age 92, of Rensselaer passed away February 28, 2011 at the George Ade Healthcare in Brook, Indiana. She was born January 11, 1919 in Wayne County, Indiana, the daughter of Joseph and Elizabeth (Harpring) Klein.
