Anita Mary (Post) Arseneau of Rensselaer, Indiana passed away November 21, 2017 at the Rensselaer Care Center. Anita was born on June 18, 1936 in Padua, Ohio, the daughter of Ubran J. and Juliana (Schwieterman) Post.
