Bronlyn “Bonnie” C. Louck, age 82, of Rensselaer, Indiana, passed away peacefully at her home on July 25, 2024. She was born on May 19, 1942 to Clark & Helen (Clark) Hutchison.

Bonnie graduated from Frankfort High School, Frankfort, Indiana, Class of 1960. After high school, she attended Indiana University. On September 1, 1962, she married Dr. Michael Louck, who passed away November 3, 2015. Together, they raised seven children.

Active in her community throughout her life, Bonnie was the owner and operator of From the Needle’s Point and Long’s Gift Shop.
