Charles E. "Charlie" Bradshaw, age 82, of Roselawn, Indiana, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 15, 2025, in Crown Point, Indiana.

Born on April 14, 1943, in Lake City, Tennessee, Charlie was the son of Charles T. and Edna (Perry) Bradshaw. He dedicated over 35 years of hard work at Ford Motor Company as a proud member of the United Auto Workers Union. 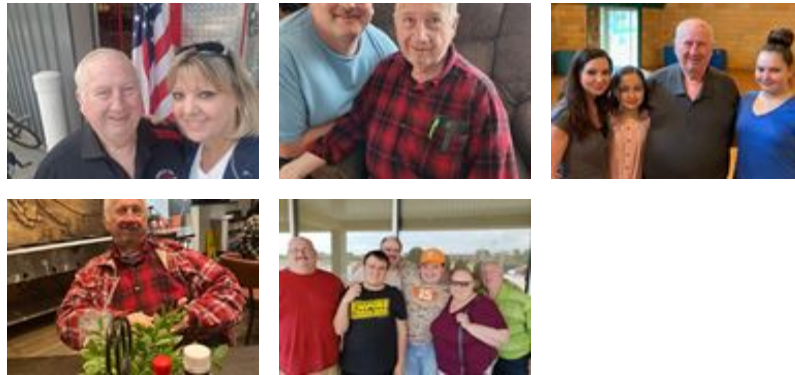
