Charles Richard Kohley, age 88, of Rensselaer, IN, passed away peacefully at home on May 1, 2025.

Born on February 4, 1937, in Rensselaer, IN to Aloysius and Myrtle (Budreau) Kohley. He was raised on his family's farm, where the values of hard work and responsibility were instilled in him early – traits that shaped the man he became. Upon graduation from Rensselaer High School, Class of 1956, he honorably served in the United States Navy. Following his military service, he dedicated 40 years of hard work to Talbert Manufacturing as a shop superintendent.

Chuck was a devoted husband to Patricia Ann (Henzler), marrying on April 28, 1962, at St. Augustine Catholic Church, and she survives. He expressed his faith as a lifetime

member of St. Augustine Catholic Church. Not only was he an avid golfer and member at Curtis Creek Country Club, but he also enjoyed his bowling and softball leagues, enriching his community through fellowship and friendship.

His legacy of kindness, humility, and hard work will live on in all who knew and loved him.

Chuck was preceded in death by his parents, Aloysius and Myrtle (Budreau) Kohley; and by his brothers, Harold Kohley, Edward Kohley, and his twin, Raymond Kohley.

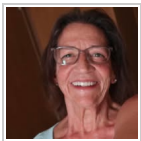
