Charles L. "Chuck" Malchow, age 83, of Muncie, Indiana, formerly of Rensselaer, passed away on February 9, 2026. He was born on August 27, 1942, in LaCrosse, Indiana, to Kenneth and Sylvia (Markley) Malchow.

Chuck was a 1960 graduate of Francesville High School. On January 1, 1966, he married the love of his life, Jackie Stults, in Medaryville, Indiana.

A skilled and hardworking tradesman, Chuck began his career working for Monon Trailer, Doc Flora in Wolcott, and Overmyer Farms. He later fulfilled a lifelong dream by opening his own business, Malchow Welding and Repair, in Wolcott, Indiana.
