Charles "Chuck" John Epler, age 89, of Rensselaer passed away Thursday, September 3, 2009. He was born September 21, 1919, in Rensselaer, the son of the late Bertha (Montgomery) and Frank Epler Sr. Chuck was a lifetime resident and a 1937 graduate of Rensselaer High School.

On December 6, 1939, in Rensselaer, he married Allene Fisher, with whom he celebrated 69 years of marriage. Chuck was a farmer from 1939-1968 and from 1966-1986 worked as a rural letter carrier with the Rensselaer Post Office. He was a member of the First Christian Church of Rensselaer where he served as a Deacon Emeritis. Chuck had been a member of the Rensselaer School Board from 1960-1968.
