



Chester R. Tuszynski

June 4, 1918 - October 24, 2010

Chester Tuszynski, age 92, inventory/aeronautical engineer and retired electrician, died Sunday, October 24, 2010 following a long battle with various ailments including cancer, in which the following offered unfaltering help and support: Anna Zimmer and family, caregivers Jeanine Jullian, Anne Casey, Elizabeth Jodtowski, the Lion's Club of Rensselaer, and many more.

He was born June 4, 1918 in the town of Inowroclaw, Poland. While in the Polish Underground at the outbreak of WWII he was interrogated by the Nazis' and later taken prisoner by the Russians who sent him to Siberia. When released, he joined the Royal Air Force, served with distinction; was wounded and was awarded several medals. He was also a member of the VFW Post #1279.

After the war, he came to the United States and worked as an electrician in Chicago, IBEW Local 134 where he was a 50 year plus member, and pursued his passion - inventions that would benefit mankind. His projects included the revolutionary Universe-O-8 aeronautical transportation system and books including "The Power of Destiny".

Chester Tuszynski is survived by Anna Zimmer, his children, daughter, Jeanine, his sons, John and Chester Ciotuszynski, granddaughter, Rebecca Ciotuszynski, nephew Jack Ciotuszynski and Anna's children, son John, daughters JoAnn Hanson, grandson Jesse, and Lona Kennedy and her husband Jim. He was preceded in death by brother Ted and wives Anastasia Ciotuszynski and Jean Bliss.
