



Cornelia "Sis" Longstreth

February 20, 1929 - January 4, 2024

Cornelia "Sis" Longstreth, aged 94, peacefully went with the Lord on January 4, 2024. Born on February 20, 1929, in Platte, South Dakota, to the late Cornelius and Effie Bierma, Sis spent her early years in Wheatfield, Indiana. Her vibrant life was adorned with passions, notably her love for bowling, where she participated in leagues and ventured to Indianapolis for tournaments. Additionally, she found joy in weekly card games with a close-knit group.

Initiating her career at her father's implement store, Sis transitioned into diverse roles, from a dedicated bus driver, a Poll Worker on Election Day, to a compassionate EMT/ambulance driver. Her final professional chapter led her to a fulfilling role as a rural mail carrier for the Wheatfield Post Office, culminating in a well-deserved retirement.

Sis is survived by her daughter, Elaine Hruz, grandchildren Britta Longstreth and Victor Hruz, great-grandchild Aiden Travers, and her brother Arthur Bierma. She joins her husband, James Longstreth, and brothers Nick, Harry, Ed, John, and Marvin Bierma in eternal rest.

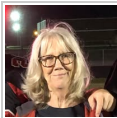
