Craig Allyn Worden, 50, of Indianapolis and a former resident of Rensselaer passed away at his home Sunday, November 11, 2012. Craig was born in Lafayette, Indiana on July 25, 1962. He was the son of Charles Worden Sr. and the late Joretta Long Worden.

Craig was a 1980 graduate of Rensselaer Central High School. He joined the United States Navy where he served until his retirement in 1995.
