Daryl M. Lintner, age 85, of Rensselaer passed away June 25, 2011 at I.U. Arnett Health in Lafayette, Indiana. Daryl was born in Rensselaer, Indiana on April 9, 1926, the son of John Lintner and Madelene (Sayler) Lintner Speaks.

Daryl entered the Army in 1944 and returned to Rensselaer in 1947 where he went back to high school and earned his degree.
