Lieutenant Colonel David Eugene Hopkins was one of four children born to Ralph Emmett, Sr. (Emmett/R.E.) and Ellen (Schreeg) Hopkins in Rensselaer, IN on March 31, 1943. Surrounded by friends and family, he passed away in March, 2022, in Hattiesburg, Mississippi.

David was preceded in death by his parents and nephew, Kimberly Charles Hopkins, along with several aunts, uncles, and cousins. He is survived by his wife, Judith K. (Brandenburg) Hopkins, and daughter, Shannon K. Hopkins, both of Georgia, and a son, Travis E. (Judy) Hopkins, of South Carolina.
