



## Devon L. "Skeet" Miller

Devon L. "Skeet" Miller, age 79, of Lake Village passed away June 25, 2011 at the Jasper County Hospital. Devon was born in Colfax Twp., Newton County, Indiana on November 24, 1931, the son of Mount Marion Miller and Lida Mosher Miller.
