Donald R. Pullins, Sr., age 91, of Rensselaer passed away on November 29, 2015, at Franciscan Health Rensselaer Alternacare. Donald was a lifetime resident of Rensselaer. He was born in rural Jasper County to Albert and Bertha (Richards) Pullins on September 18, 1924.

Donald graduated with the Class of 1943 from Fair Oaks High School. He enlisted in the United States Navy where he served in World War II. He had been a construction worker with Local #41, Hammond, Indiana and was a self-employed farmer. He was a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church in Rensselaer along with the local V.F.W. Post #1279. Donald enjoyed hunting, fishing, and his Labrador dogs. Donald was a huge Green Bay Packers fan and was an avid reader.

On September 2, 1944, in San Diego, California Donald married Wanda June Lovelady. Wanda preceded him in death on October 19, 2012.
