



## Donald H. Reichert

March 26, 1930 - April 21, 2009

Dr. Donald H. Reichert died on April 21, 2009. He was born on March 26, 1930 to Willibald Reichert and Cora Ranly Reichert in Coldwater, Ohio. Dr. Reichert was a graduate of Maryknoll High School in Clark's Summit, Pennsylvania. He graduated in 1953 from the University of Dayton and completed his master and doctorate degrees at The Ohio State University. He served in the 11th Airborne Division from 1953 to 1955.

In December 1954, he married Doris (Dubie) White in Holy Rosary Church, St. Mary's, Ohio.

They are the parents of eight children: Joseph J. Reichert of Littleton, Colorado, Mary Ann and Anthony Marinac of Highland Ranch, Colorado, Thomas W. and Dr. Usha Nair of Smyrna, Georgia, Robert J. Reichert of Crown Point, Indiana, Dr. Nancy L. Reichert and Abdul Altimimi of Alpharetta, Georgia, Amy and Tim Engelhardt of Carmel, Indiana, Catherine (Jane) and William Johnson of Kentwood, Michigan and Timothy P. and Carrie Wildman Reichert of Crawfordsville, Indiana. Dr. Reichert was preceded in death by his parents, his brother Joseph, and two of his sisters, Sister Mary Bernard Reichert C.P.P.S. and Martha A. Donahue. He is survived by Paul and Peggy Reichert, Helen and Martin Lokai, Marie and Edward Thomas, and Robert A. Reichert.

Dr. Reichert moved to Rensselaer in 1966 to teach at St. Joseph's College. He retired in 1995. He was an active member of St. Augustine's Church where he served as president of the Board of Education and a companion of the

Missionaries of the Most Precious Blood. In addition, he was active in professional organizations including the American Association of University Professors and the Philosophy of Education Association. He had strong avocational interests in mental health, and peace and justice activities.

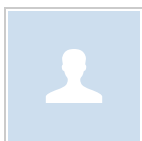
