Donna Jean Petrow, age 90, of Rensselaer, IN passed away Saturday, April 18, 2020 in her home. She was born on October 19, 1929 in McKeesport, PA to John and Clara (Urbanski) Gibb.

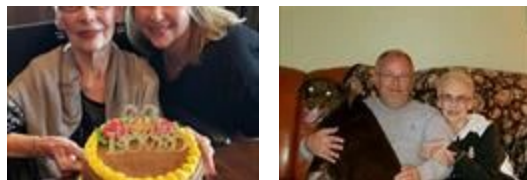
