



## Doris Imogene Maxwell

August 30, 1924 - November 10, 2024

Doris "Imogene" Maxwell, 100, of Rensselaer, IN, passed away on Sunday, November 10, 2024. She was born on August 30, 1924, in Birdseye, IN, to James and Virgie (Carmickle) Eckert.

Imogene attended the Indiana public school system and married Frank Maxwell in Logansport, IN, on May 1, 1943. They shared a devoted life together until Frank's passing on October 10, 1975. Imogene worked for over 44 years as a clerk at Superior Cleaners and Long's Gift Shop. She was also a dedicated homemaker, managing her household with great care.

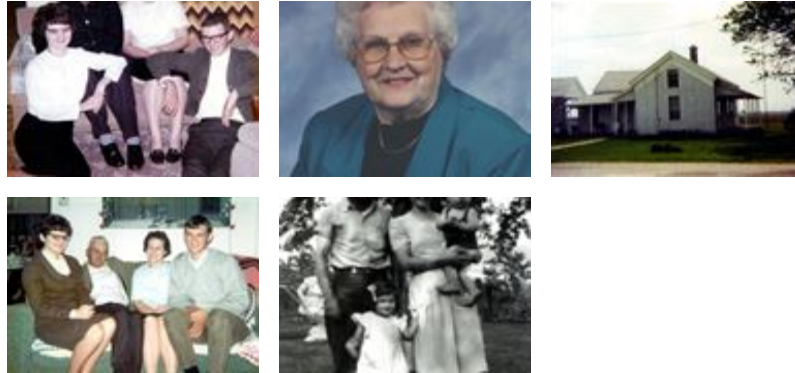
