



Dorothe J. Scipio

July 21, 1925 - October 13, 2014

Dorothe J. Scipio, age 89 of Lafayette passed away Monday, October 13, 2014 at St. Anthony's Rehabilitation and Healthcare in Lafayette where she was a resident. Born in Rensselaer, Indiana on July 21, 1925, she was the daughter of the late William B. and Georgia (Smith) Johnson. Dorothe was a former resident of Rensselaer and of White County. She graduated from Rensselaer High School with the Class of 1943.

Her marriage was at the Trinity United Methodist Church in Rensselaer on September 23, 1945 to Frank Scipio. Frank preceded her in death on March 19, 1993. She was a self-employed artist, creating crafts, paintings, quilts and wicker basketry. Dorothe was a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church in Rensselaer.

Dorothe was a charter member of the Jasper County Art League and a member of the D.A.V. Auxiliary, Prairie Arts Council, Ladies Literary Club, and Sigma Phi Gamma sorority where she was past president, and a past member of the Jasper County Hospital Auxiliary. Dorothe was a former member of the Jasper County 4-H Council and a former 15 year member of the Jasper County Fair Association where she was superintendent of the Fine Arts Department.

She was preceded in death by her husband Frank Scipio, a brother, William D. Johnson and a daughter, Sue Ann Scipio-Tredrow.

Surviving are her daughter, Kathleen A. (Chuck) Cochran of Lafayette, two sisters, Janis Wiese of Reynolds, Indiana and Arlene "Pete" Walter of

Rensselaer, five grandchildren, Melissa (Greg) Watkins, Todd (Monette) Cochran, Melinda (Alfonzo) Delgado, Alicia (William) Scott and Cody Scipio-Tredrow, eleven great-grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
