Passed away on Saturday Oct. 15, 2005 at the St. Mary Healthcare Center, Lafayette, IN. Born Oct. 17, 1933, in Hurlock, MD. he lived in Rensselaer for 33 years and was a current resident of West Lafayette since 2002. He attended Baltimore County Schools, received a bachelor's degree from Western Maryland College, a master's degree from the University of Maryland and a Ph.D. from the University of Florida, Gainesville.

A professor emeritus at Saint Joseph's College in Rensselaer, he was a professor of Biology for 33 years.

His marriage to Dorothy Ann Paul was on Dec. 17, 1966, in Washington, D.C. and she survives.

He was a private first class in the U.S. Army, serving from Jan. 3, 1956 to Jan. 2, 1962.

Dr. Jones was a member and past elder of the First Presbyterian Church in Rensselaer, regional director of Arrowhead County Regional Science Olympiad for 11 years, a member of the Indiana Academy of Science, a longtime advocate of K-12 science education throughout Indiana, and he worked on a national bird breeding survey in affiliation with Cornell University. Surviving with his wife are two daughters, Genevieve Isabel Jones of Santa Barbara, CA. and Nathalie Rose (Robert M.) Sowder of Chicago, Ill. and three sisters, Shirley Williams of Towson, MD. Lucille Fridley of Anderson, IN. and Carol (Charles) Holzman of Baltimore, MD.
