Dwight A. Williams, age 93, of DeMotte, passed away Friday, April 30, 2021 at home with his loving and caring wife by his side. Dwight was born on March 6, 1928 in Portland, Maine, the son of Allen and Eleanor (Knowles) Williams.

He graduated from Parker High School in Chicago, IL. Then, on June 17, 1953, he married Evangeline R. Heron, who survives. Dwight served his country in the United States Marine Corp. He started and served as owner & operator of D & E Transport, Inc., a trucking company he managed for 13 years.
