Eileen E. Putt, 95, of Rensselaer, Indiana, passed away on June 27, 2021 in Rensselaer, IN. Eileen was born in Rensselaer on July 21, 1925, the daughter of Guy and Nellie (DeLong) Merriman.

Eileen graduated from Rensselaer Central High School with the Class of 1943. She married the love of her life with whom she shared over 76 years of wedded bliss, Dean Putt, on November 30, 1944 in Corydon, IN, and he survives.

Eileen worked in the Clerk/Treasurer's Office for the City of Rensselaer before becoming a homemaker, caring for her family for many years, and then moving on to work at Sears in the Credit Department.

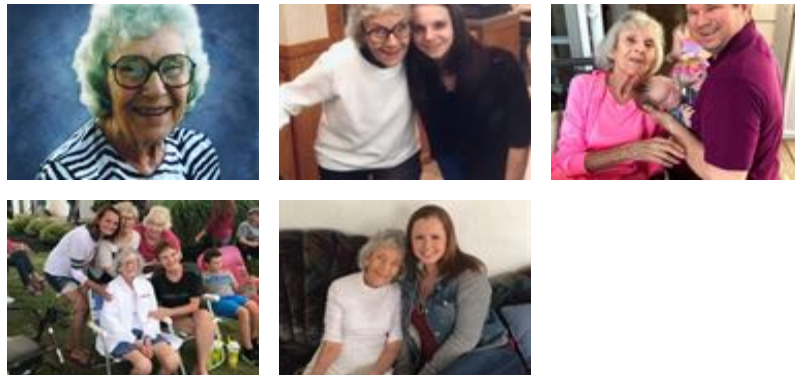
