Ethelyn Harrington, age 99, of Roselawn, IN, formerly of Hebron, IN and DeMotte, IN passed away on January 20, 2015. Ethelyn was born on May 17, 1915 in Rensselaer, IN, the daughter of John and Cora (Stump) Duggins.

Ethelyn was a 1933 Rensselaer High School graduate. On October 15, 1939, in Kouts, IN she married William Francis Harrington.
