Eugene H. Smith, age 92 of Rensselaer passed away Sunday, September 22, 2013 at the Jasper County Hospital. Eugene was born in Corydon, Indiana on March 9, 1921, the son of Minor and Anna (Tranum) Smith. Eugene moved to Rensselaer in 1948.

He was a 1940 graduate of Kentland High School. Eugene was a farmer, retiring in 1988. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Rensselaer, and a 50+ year member of Prairie Lodge #125, F & A.M. Eugene was an avid golfer and was a past member of both Curtis Creek Country Club and Hazelden Country Club.
