Harold Eugene Kohley, 89 of Rensselaer, IN passed away on Sunday, September 18, 2022, at the Rensselaer Care Center. Harold was born in Jasper County, IN on September 21, 1932, the son of Aloysius and Myrtle (Budreau) Kohley.

Harold graduated from Rensselaer High School with the Class of 1950. On July 9, 1960, in Rensselaer, IN he married Janet Nesius at the St. Augustine Catholic Church in Rensselaer, IN.
