



## Harold Max Salyers

February 3, 1930 - December 29, 2009

Harold Max Salyers, age 79, of Rensselaer passed away December 29, 2009 at Clarian Arnett Hospital, Lafayette, IN. Max was born in Rensselaer on February 3, 1930, the son of Mort and Emma Hackworth Salyers. A lifetime resident, he graduated with the class of 1948 from Rensselaer High School.
