Helen Louise Gwin, age 91, of Rensselaer passed away on June 3, 2017, at Franciscan Health Rensselaer Alternacare. Helen was born in Rensselaer, Indiana on January 17, 1926, the daughter of Frederick Christian and Carrie Mabelle (Putt) Stath and was a lifetime resident.

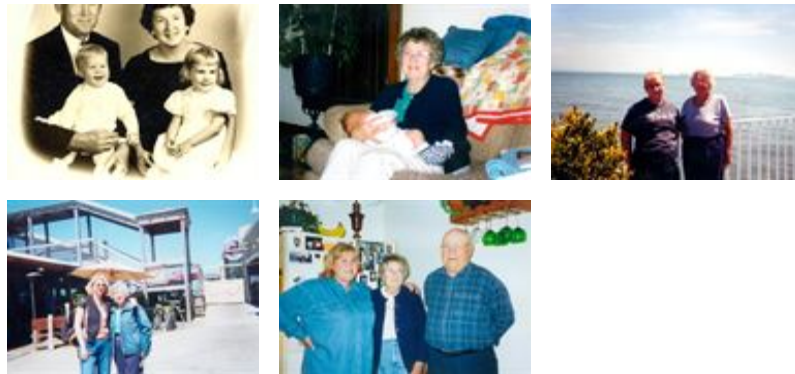
