103 year old Helen H. Hetzner of Rensselaer passed away Wednesday, June 26, 2013 at the Jasper County Hospital Alternacare. Helen was born in Cerro Gordo, Illinois on August 9, 1909. She was the daughter of Harlan and Edna Nora (Grove) Harden.

Helen graduated with the Class of 1927 from Frankfort High School. She was retired after 35 years as a supervisor at General Motors in Kokomo, Indiana. She was a member of the First Christian Church of Rensselaer, Order of Eastern Star Evening Chapter #89, Ladies Literary Club and Rensselaer Senior Citizen's. She was a former member of the Delco 35 Club.
