Jane Ellen Todd, 71, of Rensselaer, Indiana, passed away on August 22, 2021, at her home. She was born June 2, 1950 to John Patrick and Lorel Reova (Peek) Rafferty.

Jane graduated from Rensselaer High School with the Class of 1968 and then briefly attended Airline Ticketing School in Minnesota. On September 10, 1977 she married Tommy J. Todd in Rensselaer and he survives her. She was the head cook at Curtis Creek Country Club from 1990-2010. She previously cooked at her parents' restaurant, Rafferty's Bar and Grill.
