She leaves behind friends at the Kannal Avenue apartments who will miss her laugh but probably not her occasional cantankerous mood. She leaves behind her cousin Kay Printy who will miss her daily calls.

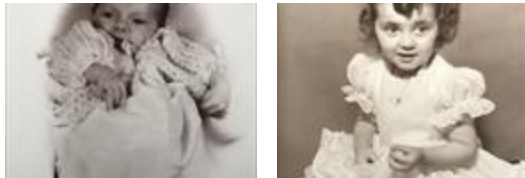

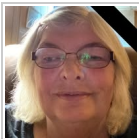
