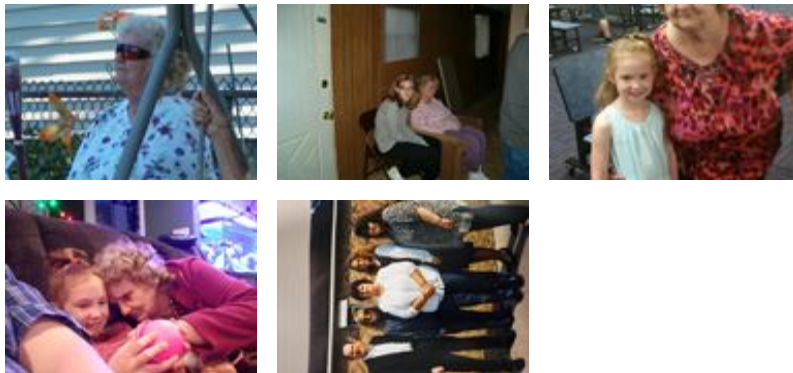
“ We always had good times visiting Judy. She got me started in fishing. We caught many catfish for dinner. We will surely miss her. She is with GOD.
