April 3, 1916 - December 17, 2014

Kathryn Hancock, age 98, of Rensselaer passed away at the Rensselaer Care Center on December 17, 2014. Kathryn was the daughter of Charles Henry and Vernia (Whiteakker) Arnold, born April 3, 1916, in Mt. Ayr, Indiana. She was a 1934 graduate of Rensselaer High School.

On March 18, 1936, in Brook, Indiana Kathryn married Ralph M. Hancock who preceded her in death on May 14, 1996. They were the parents of three children, Patricia Kay Cook, Brook, Indiana, Allen J. (Laura) Hancock, Valparaiso, Indiana and the late Richard Lee Hancock. She is also survived by 8 grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren, 6 great-great grandchildren, a daughter-in-law Judy Hancock, Brook, Indiana, sister-in-law Helen Arnold, Rensselaer, Indiana, and sister-in-law Joan Hancock, Remington, Indiana.
