



## Lawrence E. Piatt, Sr.

July 21, 1918 - April 25, 2011

Lawrence E. Piatt, Sr., age 92, passed away April 25, 2011 at George Ade Memorial Healthcare in Brook, Indiana. Lawrence, a lifetime resident of Jasper County, was born July 21, 1918, the son of William J. Piatt and Laura (Price) Piatt.

Lawrence attended school in Fair Oaks, graduating with the class of 1938. He served with the 101st Airborne in the U.S. Army. Lawrence was an avid fan of the Chicago Cubs.

On May 5, 1949, in Rensselaer, Lawrence married Ida E. Moosemiller who survives.

He retired from the Parr Elevator in 1983, where he had been a feed deliveryman for 18 years. Lawrence was a former employee of the Indiana State Highway Department, and prior to that he and his wife owned and operated the Parr Grocery Store.
