April 15, 1922 - January 25, 2014

Leonard Vander Lugt, age 91, of DeMotte, IN passed away on Saturday January 25, 2014 at Oak Grove Christian Retirement Village of DeMotte. Leonard was born in Colton South Dakota on April 15, 1922 to the late Gerrit and Alida (Swier) Vander Lugt.

Leonard had been a resident of DeMotte for the last 15 years. He had, over the years, lived in South Bend, IN., Grand Rapids, MI., and Lansing, MI. Leonard graduated from Davis Tech High School in Grand Rapids, MI., class of 1939.

On July 5, 1944 in Grand Rapids, MI. Leonard and Anne (Van Enk) Vander Lugt were married and have celebrated 69 years together. Leonard retired after 41 years of employment as a supervisor with Michigan Bell Telephone Company. Leonard proudly served his country in the Army during WWII. 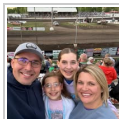
