



## Lois Ann Meyer

October 6, 1929 - April 22, 2011

Lois Ann Meyer, age 81, a Rensselaer resident since 1962, passed away April 22, 2011. She had been in declining health for two months. Lois was born in Winamac, Indiana, on October 6, 1929. She was the daughter of Albert Powers and Hazel (Zellers) Powers.

Lois was raised in Winamac. She was a graduate of Winamac High School and Saint Elizabeth School of Nursing. Lois was employed for thirty-five years as a registered nurse at the Jasper County Hospital in Rensselaer.

She was a member of the St. Augustine Catholic Church and the Christian Women's Sodality. Lois was a member of the Knights of Columbus Ladies Auxiliary and was a Fellow at St. Joseph College, both in Rensselaer. Lois was an avid card player and fan of the Chicago Cubs.

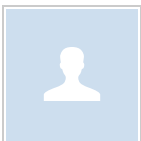
