Louise Rector, 84, of Fair Oaks, Indiana, passed away on October 21, 2021 at Northwest Health Porter in Valparaiso after a sudden illness. Louise was born in Waldon, KY on January 9, 1937, the daughter of William Arthur and Pearl Jane (Gross) Spicer.

Louise attended Fair Oaks High School. She worked as a cashier and in the serving line at St. Joseph's College Dining Services for 23 years before she retired.
