Marie Ann Peterson, age 93, of Fishers, formerly of DeMotte, passed away on Tuesday, February 13, 2018 at St. Vincent's Hospice. She was born May 28, 1924 in Chicago Heights, IL to Phillip and Alma (Nelson) Russo, both deceased.
