Marion F. Honn, age 81, of Brook, Indiana passed away Sunday, December 19, 2010 at the VA Illiana Healthcare, Danville, Illinois. He was born February 22, 1929 in Muncie, Indiana to Harry Ernest and Opal Fay (Lacy) Honn. After moving here with his family he attended school in Mt. Ayr and Brook, Indiana. Marion was a veteran of the U.S. Army.

Marion retired from Sears & Roebuck in Rensselaer where he was a mechanic for 26 years. He also had worked in maintenance at Rose Acres in Newton County.

He was a member of the First Christian Church of Brook, a life member of V.F.W.
