Jorie spent her days in the summer caring for several children including the Rodriquez girls. Her nurturing heart, patience, and genuine love for children made her a natural caregiver and a trusted friend. She was a very hard and dependable worker and was employed as an assistant manager at Dairy Queen. She developed many meaningful friendships there.

Jorie was an accomplished athlete who participated in volleyball and softball throughout her years at DeMotte Christian High School. Whether on the court, the field, in the classroom, or among friends, she led by example through quiet confidence, compassion, integrity and humor.
