Marjory A. Craig, age 94, of Rensselaer, Indiana, passed away Sunday, January 24, 2016 at the George Ade Memorial Care Center. Marjory was born in Cleveland, Ohio on January 27, 1921, the daughter of Edith C. (Comer) and Thomas A. Parsons.

Marjory received her undergraduate and Master's degree from Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio. She began her career as a student working at the Cleveland Public Library and continued her employment there after graduation as Librarian for over 30 years. She served in the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps. In September of 1943 in Yonkers, New York, she married William Alexander Craig who was killed in action during WWII. Marjory was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Rensselaer and the Gold Star Wives, an organization of widows/widowers whose spouses died while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.

Marjory is survived by one son, William (Karen) Craig of Rensselaer, two granddaughters, Cara E. Craig and Anne K. Tillett, great-grandchildren, Mira, Naelin, Alvin and Brittney. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and one brother, Frederick William Parsons.
