Michael W Campbell, 53, a lifetime resident of Rensselaer passed away Tuesday morning, October 30, 2012, at the Jasper County Hospital. Michael was born in Rensselaer, Indiana on March 9, 1959, to William F. and Jean (Pullin) Campbell.

Mike graduated from Rensselaer Central High School with the Class of 1977. While in high school, Mike played basketball and football for the Rensselaer Bombers. After high school, he attended Vincennes University studying printing technology.

For the past 34 years Mike has worked at Campbell Printing Company in Rensselaer. Along with Beulah Arnott, Mike was instrumental in starting The Vintage Views magazine, a historical magazine about Jasper County. Mike enjoyed authoring many articles for, and serving as its' editor. Michael was a member of the Rensselaer Sports Hall of Fame committee, Prairie Lodge #125, York Rite Bodies, Scottish Rite and Murat Shrine. He was affiliated with the Trinity United Methodist Church.

Along with his parents, Mike is survived by his two sisters, Marla Stanton (husband, Marshall Stanton, MD) of Orono, Minnesota and Dr. Marcia Campbell (husband, Jack Cummings) of Bloomington, Indiana. Mike is also survived by his nieces and nephews, Ian, Evan and Kaitlyn Stanton and

Sarah, Ella and Rachel Cummings.

The family will receive friends on Friday, November 2, 2012 from 3:00 to 8:00 P.M., with Masonic Lodge services at 7:30 P.M., at the Jackson Funeral Chapel of Rensselaer.
