All who met her experienced her fierce love, quiet gentleness, boundless generosity and kindness.

Milica was happiest when her hands or feet (or both) were in the dirt and she was surrounded by flowers. She hated wearing shoes because they

separated her from the Earth. She could grow anything: indoor plants, outdoor plants, food, trees, grapevines. She would heal the plants her children nearly killed and grow enough food to feed them all, even after they left home. Never one to waste, she canned the food she grew; her strawberry jam and apple pie in a jar were favorites and her vegetables stocked freezers year after year.

Milica was generous and thoughtful. She gave of herself in ways we are still discovering today. She was never boastful, she just quietly gave to others as she saw a need. She loved cooking meals and set the table to Emily Post standards for everyday meals. She always cooked enough to feed the masses and seeing her family and friends sit down to a home cooked meal brought her so much joy. She loved to sew and when she lost most of her vision, she hand quilted blankets for her family, friends and the homeless, sewing a prayer into every stitch. She sent greeting cards for any occasion or no occasion. The postal service and stationary industries will feel her loss.

The world is a slightly darker place without Milica, but her love lives on in those she touched. 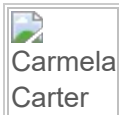

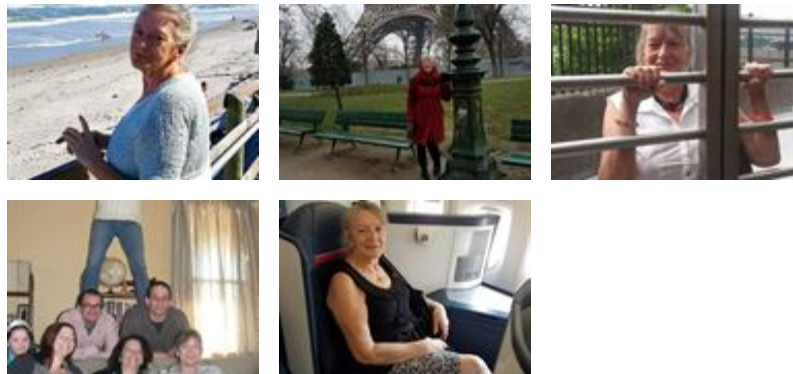
