“ Not only was Molly my little sister she was my best friend. As kids we always got in trouble together, walked to school together, got in fights together, we did everything together. I have never known a woman who showed the love of Christ like my sister Molly. When she met you if you didn't know Christ she was going to introduce you to Him. I remember the last open heart surgery she had, we almost lost her then, the night before she was cooking several meals for a family that lived behind her, the mother had cancer and was not doing good but she provided them with meals for a few days and then she started making breakfast sandwiches for us while we waited for her to have her heart surgery. She took people home one time who had a car break down on the road, she fed them and made sure they had a place to stay while their car was being repaired. She didn't know these people she just showed the love of Christ. She provided many people and families with groceries all the time. I remember when she was 15 we had a neighbor kid who was going to run away from home and Molly said she was going with him and she did, when mom found them she said she went with him so he would not be alone. She had a relationship with Christ like no other, and he used her to be a blessing to all she met. I remember one time when I was in a crisis situation and praying daily for God to help me get through this, a year later Molly told me that God did not tell her why (which He had done with her before), but He had her on her knees daily praying for me. There was not a day when we did not talk on the phone or text one another, I don't know how I'm going to navigate her not being in my life, Only God....Our comfort is that we know she is in His arms and health, and so happy to finally see her savior Jesus.

Even with her battle in health she'd say to me "God has been so good to me Billie Jo" I love you mom, tell Tommy I love him!
