Nancy Ann Hanley Ruhmann, age 89, passed away peacefully in Brownsburg, Indiana on Tuesday, May 31, 2016 with her family by her side. She was born on April 15, 1927 in Gary, Indiana, the daughter of Marian (Sherwin) and Emil Hanley. Nancy attended school in Rensselaer where she graduated with the Class of 1945 from Rensselaer High School. She attended and graduated in 1947 from Sullins College in Bristol, Virginia. Nancy also attended Butler University where she was the Drum Majorette with the Butler Band in 1948.
