Patricia A. Dunlap, age 82, of rural Rensselaer, IN, passed away on Wednesday, June 26, 2024. Born on February 2, 1942, the eldest daughter of Lawrence and Mildred (Gigrich) Holtkamp.

Pat was an alumni of Remington High School, class of 1960. Following high school, Pat graduated from St. Vincent's School of Nursing in 1963. She found a fulfilling career caring for patients as a nurse for 55 years. Pat worked for the Jasper County Health Department and formerly worked for Dr. Ockermann at the old Jasper County Hospital. A proud and dedicated nurse, Pat cared for patients, serving in numerous roles, as well as serving as a Red Cross nurse.

On June 20, 1964, Pat was united in marriage to Darrell Dunlap. Together the couple raised their family on the farm working beside each other, farming and raising livestock, for 59 years.

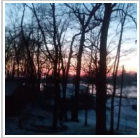
