Paul E. Bauman, age 94 of DeMotte, IN passed away on June 2, 2013 at St. Anthony's Hospital, Crown Point, In. He was born on June 3, 1918 in Churubusco, IN to Lorenz Michael And Lena Fern (nee Thompson) Bauman, both deceased.
