Paul Louis Leipert, age 75, of Rensselaer, IN, passed away on June 30, 2025, at his residence. He was born on December 10, 1949, in Chicago, IL, to Herman Leipert and Rita (Ruffle) Sypudt. Paul graduated from St. Francis de Sales High School in Chicago and proudly served his country in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War.
