Paul E. Zulaski, 74, a resident of Rensselaer, Indiana, passed away on September 28, 2023, at Franciscan Health Lafayette. Born on December 31, 1948, in Evergreen Park, IL, Paul was the beloved son of Clarence and Mary Catherine (Duffin) Zulaski.

Paul dedicated thirty years of his career as a retired assembler at the former Reiter Automotive Systems in Lowell. A proud veteran, he served in the US Army during the Vietnam War. Paul found solace in his faith and was a member of St. Augustine Catholic Church in Rensselaer.

A man of varied interests, Paul delighted in travel, attending air shows, and leisurely rides on his bicycle through town. He cherished moments spent with friends, reveled in music, and was an ardent Green Bay Packers fan. Above all, his greatest joy came from the love of his family, especially his grandchildren.

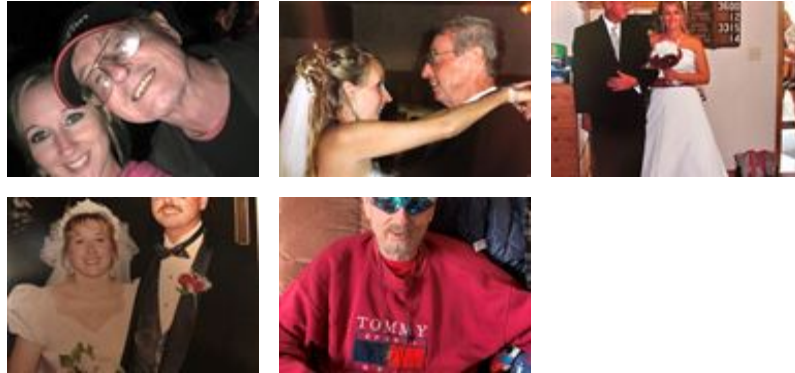
