Pearl J. Schoon Hoffman, 88, of Wheatfield, Indiana, passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, February 13, 2025, surrounded by her loved ones.

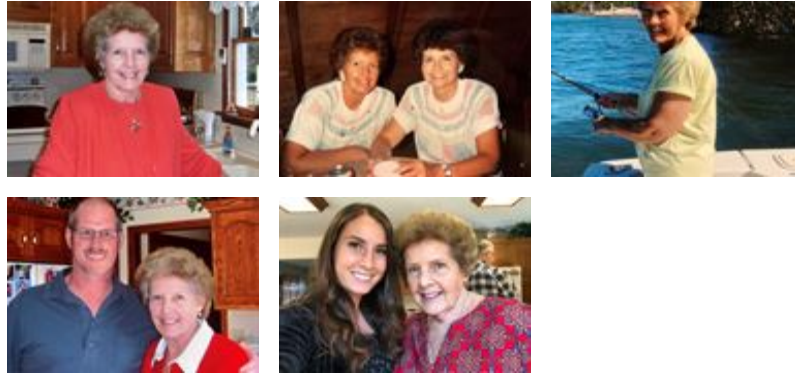
